SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY



Uniform links the pupils to the school and creates a sense of pride and belonging. We believe that it also contributes to maintaining standards of discipline.

- One pair of stud earrings can be worn. No other jewellery is allowed.
- Make-up is not allowed.
- Unnatural hair colouring is not allowed e.g. blue, purple, pink, green.
- Natural coloured nail varnish is allowed on natural nails False nails are not allowed.

Please note:

THE PUPILS NAME NEEDS TO BE CLEAR ON ALL CLOTHES.

Failure to comply:

If the pupil does not comply with the School Uniform Policy and the rules noted above, teachers will raise the matter with the pupil. In the event of a regular failure to follow the Policy the teacher will take the following steps:

- 1. The first time a pupil fails to conform to school rules a verbal warning will be given to the pupil with an explanation of what does not comply with the Policy.
- 2. The second time, there will be a verbal warning and explanation, then the parent / guardian will be contacted to raise the concern.
- 3. The third time, again there will be a verbal warning and contact with the parent / guardian and the pupil will be detained in lunch time detention.

A pupil will not be excluded for not wearing the correct uniform, but may receive detention if there is a persistent pattern of failing to conform.

Exceptions:

At times it is not possible for a pupil to wear the correct uniform. In such a case parents should contact the school by letter or phone explaining the problem. A pupil will only be allowed not to wear the correct uniform for a period of one week.

If there is a specific medical condition that means the pupil cannot wear the correct uniform a medical letter must be provided or entry made within the pupil's Additional Learning Needs Individual Learning Plan identifying the issue.

In very rare cases, where a pupil's lack of attendance is a major concern the Management Team will prioritize the safety and inclusion of the pupil over ensuring that the uniform is correct. However, the pupil will be expected to comply with the uniform in the long term.


