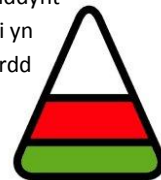
Diwrnod Blasu

Lori Ni

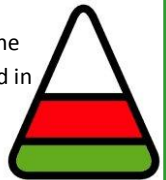
