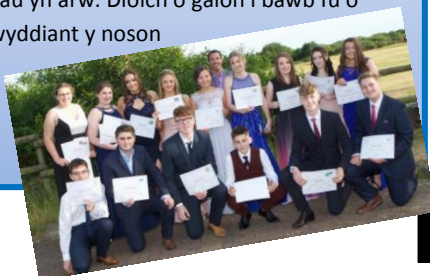
## Strategaeth Iaith Uwchradd Gwynedd
