## What will I be learning?

You will learn how the construction industry is structured and the many employment opportunities there are within the industry. You will compare modern and traditional methods of construction while drawing your own solutions to housing design problems. Some of the design problems will have a practical solution. There will be work experience during the two years of study.

## How will I be learning?

You will follow twelve modules; the first three being compulsory. Every module is 30 hours long. You will research, report, create presentations, create plans for buildings, discover a large amount of interesting and current facts on how to build now and in the future.

## How will I be assessed?

Each module is graded Pass, Merit and Distinction and it is not possible to move on to the Merit unless all the Pass criteria are met. There is no examination in this subject, it is continual assessment. This course is equivalent to 4 GCSE's from A\*-C grade.
