

BTEC Award and Certificate in Work Skills

What does the course offer me?

The Edexcel BTEC Award and Certificate in Work Skills (Level 1 & 2) have been designed to provide:

- the knowledge, understanding and skills learners need to enter employment;
- opportunities for learners to gain a nationally-recognised qualification relating to work skills;
- opportunities for learners to develop a range of skills and techniques, personal qualities and attitudes essential for successful performance in working life.

How will I learn?

- Workskills will be delivered through the Welsh Baccalaureate.
- Practical sessions to develop skills and understanding.
- Individual and group activities.

How will I be assessed?

In the Edexcel BTEC Award and Certificate in Work Skills (Level 1/2), all units are internally assessed. The overall grading is a pass, based upon the successful achievement of the required number of credits.

To be awarded the Edexcel BTEC Award in Work Skills (Level 1/2) the learner must achieve a minimum of 3 credits.

To be awarded the Edexcel BTEC Certificate in Work Skills (Level 1/2) the learner must achieve a minimum of 13 credits.

The aim of Work Skills is to deliver the skills that will help people gain and retain a job.
