

What does the course offer me?

This course will help you learn about the following:

- Developing, Planning and Communicating Ideas;
- Product Analysis;
- Sustainability and Legislative Issues;
- Other Designers / Practitioners;
- Commercial Manufacturing Practices;
- Material and Components;
- Tools, Equipment and Making;
- ICT, CAD and CAM;
- Systems and Processes.

How will I learn?

As a fundamental part of their course, candidates will design and make products and then evaluate their performance. They will be given the opportunity to experience the variety of roles involved with the subjects - client, designer, maker, manager, user, etc. There will be two hours of lessons per week.

How will I be assessed?

- Coursework (60%)
Pupils will complete a task set by the WJEC. The task will be of 30 hours duration under controlled assessment conditions where candidates will design, make and evaluate the task.
- Examination (40%)
Candidates will sit a two hour written paper at **the end of Year 11**.

Remember!

- The new syllabus does not allow you to choose a task of your choice in Year 11.
- Although a practical subject, it does have a great deal of folio work, and homework is set on a regular basis.
- It is recommended that you do not choose Resistant Materials and Graphics.
