

Who will deliver this course?

What will I learn?

This course will help you to learn:

- About the different types of career options open to you in the health and social care sectors and how you can prepare for them;
- About communication in Health and social Care
- About individual rights in the health and social care sectors;
- About individual needs in the health and social care sectors;
- About ensuring safe environments;
- About human lifespan development.

How will I learn?

You will be taught by experienced health and social care lecturers. The course is a mix of classroom and practical tasks. You will get a chance to prepare and practise your skills before you are assessed so that you know and understand what you will have to do.

How will I be assessed?

You will produce coursework and assignments which are assessed mainly by your course tutor with some external assessment. There are no exams to sit on this course.

What happens after this course?

After Year 11, you could go on to complete the BTEC First Diploma at Level 2 or move on to a BTEC National Diploma at Level 3. You could also do an NVQ or Modern Apprenticeship at Level 2 or 3 in a related sector. After all this, you will be well prepared for work in a suitable role under supervision.

But, if you don't fancy carrying on with health and social care, you could choose other suitable qualifications depending on what you want to look at next. Your careers adviser will be able to help you with your choices when you leave school.
