

## What does the course offer me?

This course provides opportunities to practise:

- Reading skills by responding to prose, poetry and drama.
- Writing skills by producing both imaginative and transactional pieces.
- Speaking and Listening Skills in a variety of situations.

## How will I learn?

- There are three lessons a week shared between English and Literature.

## How will I be assessed?

### Examination

**Paper 1**      **20%**    **1 hour**  
Non fiction texts

**Paper 2**      **20%**    **1 hour**

Two writing tasks conveying information and expressing opinion.

### Controlled Assessment

#### Spoken Language 20%

- Extended individual contributions.
- Group discussion and interaction.
- Drama focused activities.
- Studying spoken language.

#### Written 30%

- Studying written language – literary text
- Writing – descriptive.
- Writing – narrative.

All tasks must be completed under teacher supervision.

Foundation tier – grades G – C

Higher tier – grades D – A\*
